**Pasta Salad**

**An easy pasta salad is to just cook your favorite pasta, such as bow ties, until tender according to package directions. Remove pasta without spilling out water. Take a frozen bag of mixed vegetables such as broccoli, cauliflower and carrots and place contents of bag into pasta water. Cook until unfrozen. Place strained vegetables in strained pasta. Add a cup or more of your favorite fat free salad dressing (Italian). Done. You can also add chickpeas, red beans, etc. for added protein. Serve warm or chilled in refrigerator at least 1 hour.**

Prep Time: 15 mins +. Chill Time 1 hours + Total Time: 1 hour + 15 mins +. Serves 6 +

**Ingredients**

- 1 box bow tie pasta
- 2 medium tomatoes, (roma)
- 1 summer squash and/or zucchini
- 1 medium broccoli crown
- ½ medium red onion
- 15 oz jar roasted red peppers (2/3 jar)  
(You can roast your own red peppers.)
- ½ bunch parsley
- Salt and pepper to taste after you put on your favorite dressing.

**Directions**

- Bring a large pot of water to boil. Add pasta and cook until tender.
- Drain in a colander
- While you are waiting for the pasta water to boil and the pasta to cook, wash the vegetables and cut them into bite sized pieces (onions and red pepper thinly sliced; parsley removed from stems and chopped).

Any summer vegetable you need to use up does well here. You can even mix fresh and frozen vegetables.

**Expand Your Knowledge at the Brooklyn and Queens Public Libraries**
